2026

After two very successful winter tests for McLaren, Patrick Schober joins the McLaren Academy and competes in the McLaren Artura Evo in the **McLaren Trophy Europe**.

2025

Some notable successes in **EuroNASCAR Open** with the RDV Competition team, but also a lot of bad luck with technical problems and frequently being involved in collisions through no fault of his own.

2024

VICE-EUROPEAN CHAMPION in **EuroNASCAR Open** with 3 pole positions, 2 wins, 8 top 5 and 11 top 10 and **EUROPEAN CHAMPION** in EuroNASCAR Endurance with Team RDV Competition and Paul Jouffreau

2023

This season, the focus was 100% on **EuroNASCAR Open**, with Patrick Schober competing for the Double V Racing team from Italy, as he did last year. The goal this time was to finish in the Top 5, and Patrick Schober was able to achieve this goal in almost every race. Patrick Schober **won the NASCAR Grand Prix of Germany**, giving the Double V Racing team and himself their first victory in EuroNASCAR Open.

A further 4 podium finishes rounded off the 2023 season, where he ended in fourth place overall in points.

2022

As the top graduate of the EuroNASCAR recruitment program, Patrick Schober was able to compete in EuroNASCAR in 2022. The objective was to finish in the Top 10 and with more than 30 drivers in the field, this was a very ambitious goal for a rookie. This goal was achieved in many races and Patrick Schober also finished **P10 in the overall classification**. Patrick Schober also competed in a Formula 4 race at the Slovakia Ring for a round of the FIA-CEZ. Although Patrick had to drive the old Formula 4 Tatuus model for this weekend, he was still able to **win both races**.

2021

Goals achieved: 4-time Formula 4 Champion

1. **FIA-CEZ – Central European Champion Class Formula 4**
2. **Austrian National Champion Formula 4**
3. **Champion Drexler Automotive Cup**
4. **Champion ESET V4 Cup**

Patrick Schober was often able to prevail against his opponents in direct duels and won every second race on average.

The touring car races in the Histo-Cup in a BMW E46 325i were also very successful and led to the top spot in the YT3 - 2500 cc class.

In December, Patrick was given the opportunity to take part in a **EuroNASCAR** recruitment in France. He was able to complete this recruitment as the best of all international participants.

From 2022, Patrick Schober will also be a member of **motorSPORTaktiv.at**, which will take care of Patrick Schober's interests in EuroNASCAR.

2020

Patrick Schober competed in four different championships with the Formula 4 in 2020.

In the **FIA-CEZ** - the Central European Championship, the **Austrian Racing Car Championship**, the **Drexler Automotive Cup** and the **ESET V4 Cup**.

Patrick Schober won 4 of these 12 different races, achieved second place 6 times and third place twice. Overall, Patrick Schober finished runner-up in all 4 championships.

Until the middle of the season, Patrick Schober was leading the overall standings of the FIA CEZ and was neck and neck with his rivals in the other championships **until an obscure and more than strange act by the Slovakian motorsport authorities brought about a turnaround**.

His appearances as a guest entrant in the **Histo Cup** at the Slovakia Ring and at the Red Bull Ring, where he drove a touring car for the first time and showed sensational performances in the rain in the various formula racing cars, were also outstanding.

2019 represents another significant milestone in his career, after he won the **Formula Historic** class FY1 (YoungTimer 1) in superior style and also completed his first race outings in Formula 4.

Patrick Schober is also the youngest title winner in Austrian racing history. In the Austrian racing car championship, he took second place and is therefore also the **Austrian vice national champion** in Formula 4.

2018 saw Patrick Schober drive in his first Formula races as a 14-year-old in a **Formula ADAC Masters** and in a **Formula König**. He also won the Slovakian Karting Cup and achieved first place in the **ESET V4 Cup L21 in the Formula Junior** class. He also finished second overall in the Formula Historic class FY1 (YoungTimer 1).

2017 saw Patrick take part in races in the **Rotax Max Junior** class and once again achieve second place in the Slovakian Karting Cup. He went on to represent the Slovak Republic at the season finale, the **ROTAX MAX CHALLENGE GRAND FINALS**, 2017 in Portimao, Portugal.

2016 represents a significant milestone in Patrick's career, after he tested a Formula racing car for the first time at the age of 10 and was able to gain valuable experience in many test drives in the following years.

2015 saw Patrick already occupy 4th place in the overall classification of the **Rotax Micro Max** kart class.

2014 Patrick was 2nd place in the **Rotax Mini Max** class, 2nd place in the Slovakian Karting Cup and 3rd place in the Austrian championship.

Where it all began: After driving a rental kart at the age of 4, Patrick's next step was to get his own kart. At the age of 8, he began his racing career in the **Rotax Micro Max** class, where he immediately achieved 6th place in the championship as the best newcomer (equivalent to “Rookie of the Year”).
